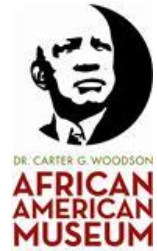


LEAVING A LEGACY

- Please print clearly
- Maximum 3 lines per brick. All lines will be centered
- No company logos
- Text will be engraved in ALL CAPS with the exception of a small “c” in last name such as “McDonald”
